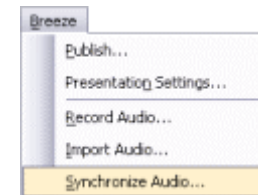


Synchronising Audio

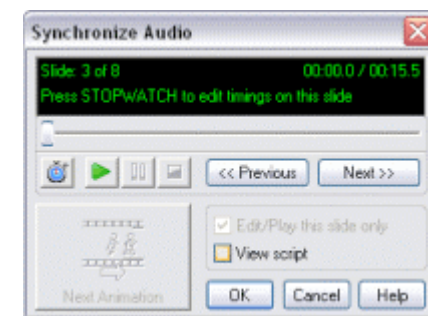
In much the same way as 'Rehearse Timings' works in PowerPoint, you can synchronise your audio to the presentation.

From the 'Breeze' menu, select 'Synchronise Audio'.



The 'Synchronise Audio' dialog box will open.

Having recorded audio, this dialog box will be very familiar to you, however the 'Record' button has been replaced by the 'Stopwatch' button.



To start editing the timings of the slide, click the 'Stopwatch' button.

Your slide will replay with the accompanying audio.
