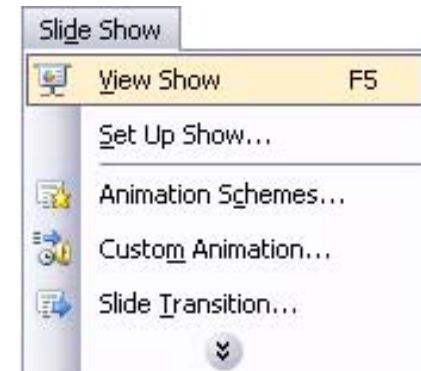


Viewing a Presentation

There are 3 ways to view a presentation.

From the '**Slide Show**' menu, select '**View Show**'.

PowerPoint will replay your show using the full screen. To advance the slides, click the mouse button.



At the end of the slideshow, the screen will go blank displaying at the top of the screen the message

End of slide show, click to exit.

Click anywhere and the screen will return to the PowerPoint window.

Alternatively you can begin a presentation by pressing '**F5**' on the keyboard.

The third method of viewing a presentation allows you to control the start-point.



Slide Show from current slide (Shift+F5)

Click the **'Slide Show' button** underneath the Outline/Slides pane.

The slideshow will begin from the current slide selected in the main PowerPoint window.

TIP – *It is also possible to control the slideshow by using the cursor keys – this has the advantage of allowing you to go backwards as well as forwards in your presentation.*
