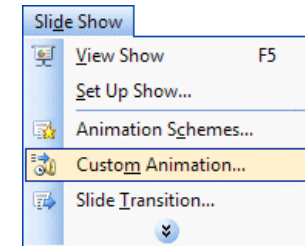


The Advanced Timeline

For more complex timings of animations, you can use the advanced timeline.

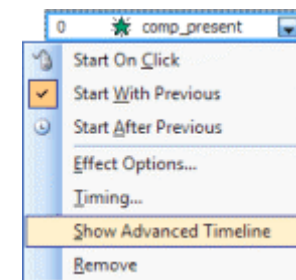
To see the advanced timeline, select **'Custom Animation'** from the 'Slide Show' menu.



In the task pane, click on an object with animation to select it.

Click the **drop down arrow** at the right of the object.

From the drop down menu that appears, select **'Show Advanced Timeline'**.

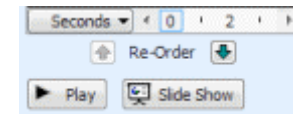


An Introduction to Microsoft® PowerPoint® 2003

The task pane will alter to show the advanced view of your animations. Each animation is displayed as an orange block whose length is determined by the amount of time it is displayed for.

Using the advanced timeline, you can accurately see the overlaps of your animations.

Click 'Play' to replay your slide and see the animations displayed on a timeline.



You can now alter the event handler ('on click', 'with previous', 'after previous') and the timing of the animation using the skills you have already (see 'lesson 22 - Animation' for further details.)

To close the advanced timeline view, **click** the **drop down arrow** at the right of any object, and **select 'Hide Advanced Timeline'** from the drop down menu.
